

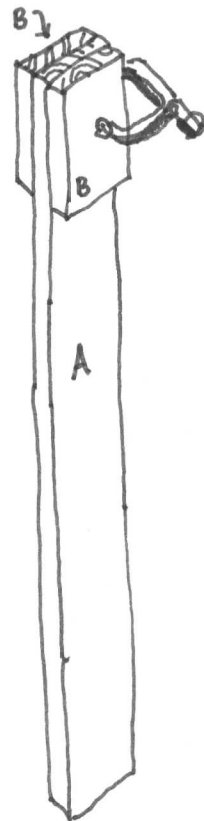
MAKING THE TIMBER-FRAME

MAKING THE COLUMNS 1

EACH COLUMN IS UNIQUE, SO THE FIRST TASK IS TO IDENTIFY THE RIGHT BITS OF TIMBER FOR EACH COLUMN. YOU WILL HAVE TEN PILES OF TIMBER. START WITH ONE PILE = ONE COLUMN.

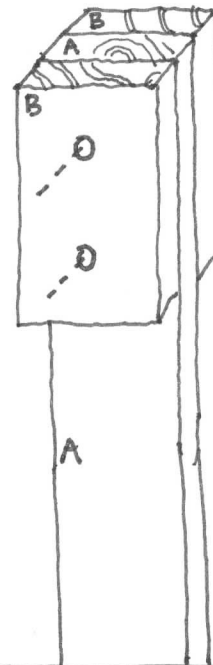
- A = 1 COLUMN CENTRE
- B = 2 COLUMN TOPS
- C = 2 COLUMN MIDDLES
- D = 2 COLUMN BASES

START WITH THE TOPS



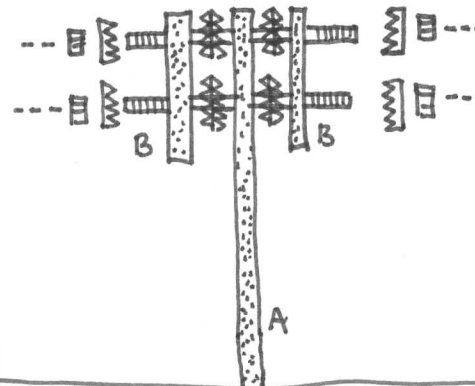
CLAMP THE A AND B PIECES TOGETHER IN THE RIGHT POSITION.

THEN



DRILL 2 HOLES.

UN-CLAMP AND THREAD THE PIECES TOGETHER THEN TIGHTEN.



FROM ONE SIDE :

- 1 NUT
- 2 SINGLE SIDED CONNECTOR
- 3 TIMBER PIECE B
- 4 DOUBLE SIDED CONNECTOR
- 5 TIMBER PIECE A
- 6 DOUBLE SIDED CONNECTOR
- 7 TIMBER PIECE B
- 8 SINGLE SIDED CONNECTOR
- 9 NUT.
